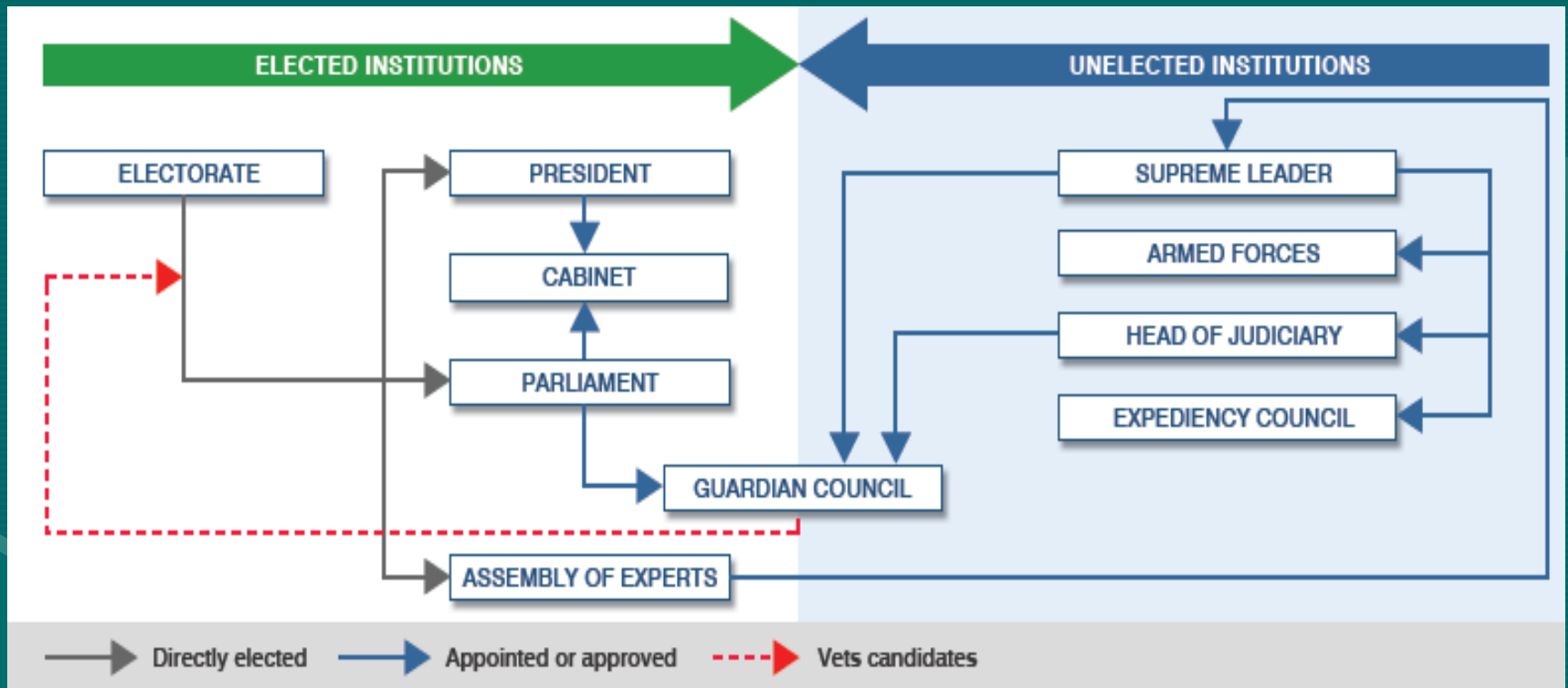

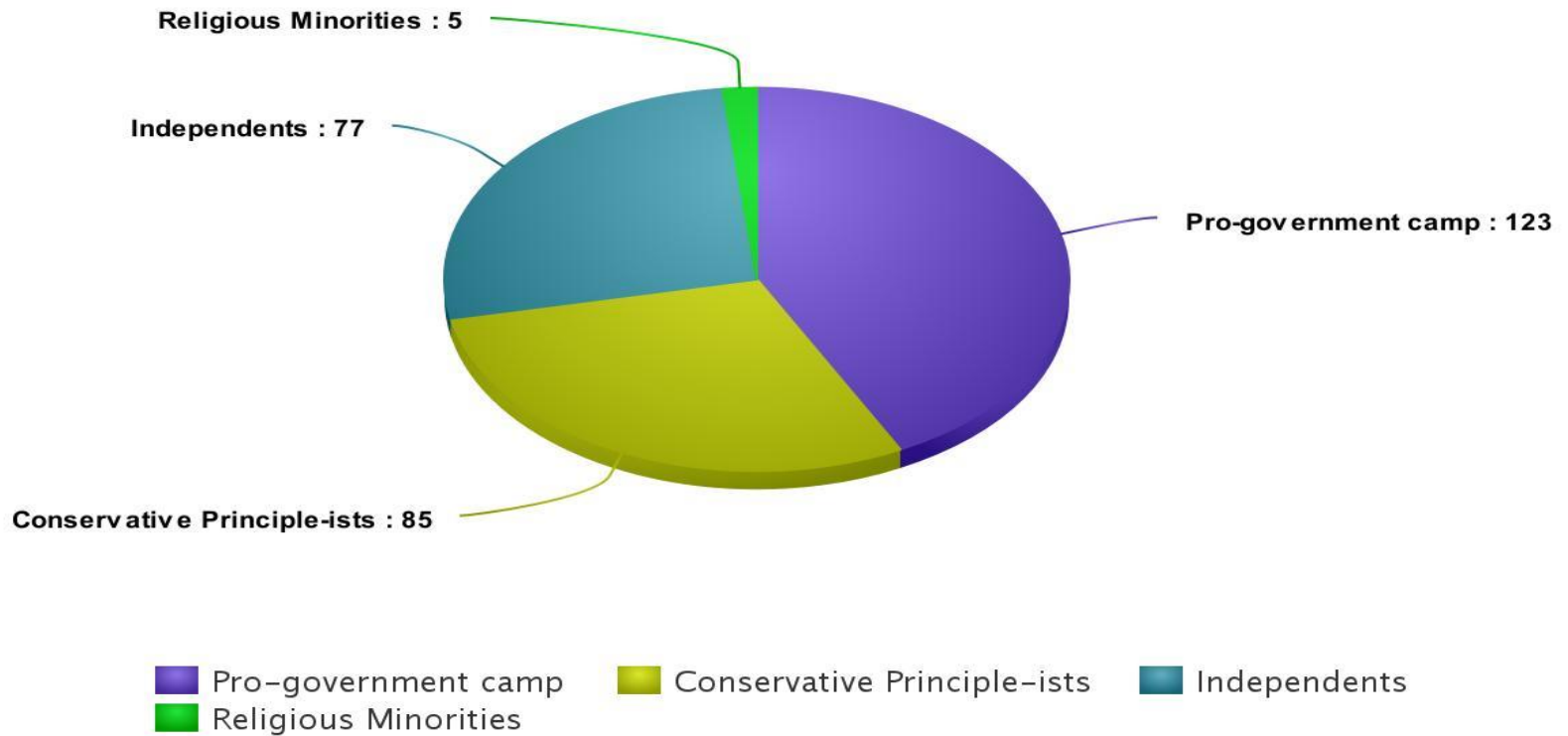


Parliamentary Election Results

- Pro-government camp won 42.4 per cent of parliamentary seats (123), with principle-ists gaining around 29.3 per cent (85).
- Around 26.6 per cent (77) of elected candidates are "independent", but are likely to support pro-government faction.
- Five seats (1.7 per cent) belong to religious minorities, including Jews, Christians and Zoroastrians, who are generally inclined towards moderate groups.

Facelift

- 217 MPs, or 75 per cent, who served in the current parliament (2012 - 2016), will not be present in the next Majlis.
- Out of 24 MPs who are in the parliament's Energy Committee, only one was re-elected
